Awards – Black F

Mrs. Bamford

To qualify for this award, a graduating student must have demonstrated a commitment to and actively participated in at least eight (8) school-based, **non-athletic** student activities. Participation in the same activity for four years constitutes four (4) activities. A list of potential activities is listed in the FHS Student Handbook on page 15 (note: there may be student activities which do not appear on the list).

Small and Large Athletic **Yellow F**

SMALL YELLOW F

1 team for 3 years at the same level - Ex 3 years of a Varsity Volleyball

Being on 5 different teams - JV Soccer (1 year) + JV Basketball (1 year) + Varsity Track (1 year) + Varsity Volleyball (1 year) + JV Badminton (1 year) = 5 teams

Not eligible – 2 years of a JV sport, 2 years of a Varsity sport, 1 year of Track = 3 teams

LARGE YELLOW F

8 teams over four years

Each year on a team counts as 1 team. For example: 2 years of JV Soccer = 2 teams

Example: 2 years JV Soccer + 2 years Varsity Basketball + 1 year Badminton + 1 year Volleyball + 2 years Track = 8 teams
