## Notice to F.H.S Grads- 2023

- **Marks:** Grade 12 students return to school for marks on Monday, June 19<sup>th</sup> at 8:30am. Please see your homeroom teacher upon arrival. Students failing to graduate will be informed by their Guidance Counselor prior to the date above. Unsuccessful graduates will be refunded 50% of their grad fee, which Mrs. Woodhouse will complete online.
- **Black & Yellow Grad Assembly:** Thursday, June 8<sup>th</sup> 2023, Period 3  
Please wear your black and yellow for this event! Grads will be celebrated with In-House Scholarships, Athletic Awards, Fine Arts Awards, Student of the Year award and the Valedictory Address. We will be ending this event with a graduating class photo of all 2023 Grads! A link will be shared with families to watch through Microsoft Teams.
- **Prom:** Monday June 19<sup>th</sup> (6:30 p.m. -10:00 p.m.)  
Tickets purchased after May 8<sup>th</sup> will cost \$35.00 and must be purchased from Mrs. Woodhouse (debit/credit). Only eligible graduates may purchase tickets for themselves and one guest. Your guest may be no older than 21 years of age. If your guest is asked to leave due to unexpected behavior, you will be asked to leave as well.

Parents are welcome to go to the Wu Center for the traditional “prom watch” and to view the procession from 6:30- 8:00 p.m. PARENTS WILL NOT BE PERMITTED IN THE WU CENTER.

When a grad leaves prom, they are not permitted to return. There will be a DJ as well as punch, water, and finger foods available throughout the night. The last song is at 9:50pm.

- **Safe Grad:** Monday June 19<sup>th</sup>, 2023- Tuesday June 20<sup>th</sup>, 2023 (11:00 p.m.-6:00 a.m.)  
Students are to notify their homeroom teacher by **Friday June 2nd** if they are planning to attend Safe Grad. Guests are not permitted to attend Safe Grad; this is an event for FHS Grads only. Safe Grad will be held at Fredericton High School, with several activities planned throughout the night. Food and drinks will be provided all night. Students should arrive at the school anytime between 10:30pm and 11:00pm. **Students must be dropped off by an adult. Vice-Principals will be greeting Grads at the F-WING doors and we will be conducting bag checks.** If you have signed up for Safe Grad and do not show, the school will be calling home to notify. Fredericton City Police may be in attendance throughout the night. Families should decide on morning pick up as we wish a safe return home. Students can start to leave at 5:00am if they wish. If leaving Safe Grad at any point throughout the night, you must notify an administrator at the event, and a parent will be called for transportation.
- **Graduation Ceremonies:** Wednesday June 21<sup>st</sup>  
We will continue with a walk-through ceremony event and encourage families to invite their guests to join you. We recommend up to 10 guests per family. If additional guests are required, please reach out to your child's vice-principal to assist with planning for a larger group. Guests with mobility issues will have an alternate route through our school to get to the gym location. Gowns will be sent home with students before the event. The graduation gown comes with a card with your name on it. Graduates will use this card on Graduation Day to announce their names. **Please bring this card with you.** We will be sending maps home to help with parking and traffic flow throughout the building. We look forward to seeing our Graduates!
